



The Robert Naski Memorial Career Technical Scholarship 2019 Scholarship Application

Recommended Accomplishments for the Scholarship Applicant:

(other criteria may be considered based on submitted applications)

1. Must have GPA of a 2.5, **or** an SAT score of 910 or ACT of 17 or higher.
2. Other criteria shall be considered in lieu of GPA and SAT/ACT scores. This includes the demonstration of academic growth while attending one of Warren Consolidated Schools Programs. The applicant should describe such growth in the Essay required for the application.
3. Must plan to attend a state of Michigan institution that grants a degree, certification, or license.
Additionally, the applicant is eligible if attending one of the following private institutions: Adrian College; Albion College; Baker College – Flint/Owosso; Davenport University-Eastern Region Campus; Finlandia University; Kendall College of Art and Design at Ferris State University; and University of Detroit-Mercy.
4. Must have at least one family member affiliated with a labor union and be in good standing either current or retired. Family members include: parents, grandparents, siblings, first aunts/uncles.
5. Demonstrate involvement in school related or community based extracurricular activity.
6. Obtain a signed letter of recommendation from at least one or more of the applicant's high school teachers.
7. Must submit with the application, an essay of no more than 400 words on the relevance of the labor union in their life. The essay must be typed in 12-point font and double-spaced.
8. Must mail the signed application, essay, and recommendation letter(s) should be mailed together and must be RECEIVED by the second Wednesday in April.

By signing the application, you are authorizing the WEA Scholarship Foundation to reprint and distribute your essay in press releases and newsletters.
