2021-2022 Cosmetology Program Information

Warren Woods Public Schools is a state licensed Cosmetology facility. Cosmetology I will be held at Warren Woods Tower High School from 1:30 to 5:33 daily. The last two weeks of June are 7-hour days from 7:30am -3:00pm.

Suggestions

1. The student has the tenacity to complete a two-year program.
 - a. Students need to commit to taking the two-year program, as we want completers of the Cosmetology program to successfully pass the licensing exam to become a licensed Cosmetologist.
 - b. Students need to commit to attending a 4 hour/3 minute daily class schedule including 10 days of 7 hours at the end of June.
 - i. Attendance is of *utmost importance*. Failure to obtain required hours creates ineligibility for Cosmetology State License through our program.
 - c. Dexterity, agility, and eye-hand coordination are important characteristics for a student to be successful.
2. The student has great attendance to school.
 - a. Cosmetology requires students to earn 750 clock hours per year. Students need 1500 clock hours to qualify themselves to take the licensing exam in Cosmetology. There is a practical section and a written/theory section for the state-licensing exam.
 - b. There is very little wiggle room to make-up missed hours each school year.
 - c. There should not be any major student discipline issues.
3. The student is in line to graduate with their graduating class.
 - a. We have determined that students that are behind in their graduation credits rarely complete the two-year Cosmetology program.
 - b. Seats in the program are limited due to facility restraints; so careful Career Pathway selection is necessary.

Other Notes

4. The cosmetology program for 2021-2022 is for juniors only and Cos I only. Cosmetology is a 2-year program with a requirement for 1,500 state-mandated hours--750 each year.
5. Cosmetology I students are NOT automatically “rolled over” to Cosmetology 2. In order to progress to Cosmetology 2, students must be on track to meet the 1,500-hour requirement. Student hours are reviewed beginning in March of their first year and we will contact counselors and parents where concerns exist.
6. All selected students and parents must attend a parent meeting in August 2021. Letters will be sent to all selected students with the date and time.
7. Transportation is not provided
8. Cosmetology students will follow WWTHS schedule, attendance policy and discipline policies.
9. Counselors will work students on having a strong backup plan if they do not get accepted into the cosmetology I class for 2021-2022. Space is extremely limited. Please make sure only serious students are selected and submitted for consideration.
