- (C) NO STUDENT, PARENT, GUARDIAN, SCHOOL, NOR ANY OTHER ENTITY OR PERSON, MAY COMPEL THE CLUB TO AWARD OR PAY ANY SCHOLARSHIP, UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES, EVEN IF THE CLUB VIOLATES ITS OWN RULES.
- (D) ALL DECISIONS OF THE CLUB ARE FINAL. NO ONE CAN APPEAL THE CLUB'S DECISIONS UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES. ALL PARENTS, GUARDIANS AND STUDENTS WAIVE ANY AND ALL LEGAL RIGHTS THAT THEY MAY HAVE (1) TO SEEK PAYMENT OF A SCHOLARSHIP, (2) TO DISPUTE THE AWARD OF ANY AND ALL SCHOLARSHIPS, AND (3) TO SEEK ISSUANCE OF A SCHOLARSHIP.
