SUMMER SCHOOL COURSE INFORMATION

Regardless of the individual student's goals for earning credits or the setting that they choose for their learning, all Summer School coursework is aligned with WCS District curriculum, meeting the State of Michigan Standards and Benchmarks. The WCS Student Code of Conduct is strictly enforced. Violation of the Student Code of Conduct will result in immediate dismissal and loss of credit(s) with no refunds.

Summer school courses condense 90-hours of instruction into 60-hours. We are able to accomplish this because many variables that impact the normal school day are eliminated in summer school (e.g. changes of class, no interruptions, no missed days or hours, etc.). The majority of students re-taking classes have previously been exposed to the material, thus allowing teachers to speed up the pace of instruction; the classes that students may enroll in for Accelerated Credits and Enrichment (ACE) are limited based on complexity of content and require the student's counselor to approve that the student has the ability to learn the material at an accelerated pace.

Attendance Policy

- ◆ There are NO EXCUSED ABSENCES!
- ◆ Each day is divided into two - 2.5 hour sessions.
- ◆ Students may not miss more than 1 full day or 5 hours of class time.
- ◆ Students missing in excess of the 5 hours will not earn credit for that course nor will they receive a refund.
- ◆ Students arriving up to 10 minutes late to either session will be counted as tardy, 3 accumulated tardies will count as a one-half day (2.5-hours) absence.
- ◆ Students arriving more than 10-minutes late to either session will be assessed a one-half day (2.5 hours) absence.
- ◆ Students returning up to 5-minutes late from any break will be counted as tardy.
- ◆ Students returning more than 5-minutes late from any break will be assessed a one-half day (2.5-hours) absence.
- ◆ Sleeping in class is not tolerated and will result in the student being assessed a one-half day (2.5-hours) absence.

Classroom Courses (Teacher-based instruction)

- ◆ Every effort will be made to conduct all core-content area classes in the traditional classroom setting.
- ◆ Based on enrollment, a determination will be made as to whether or not a course will run.
- ◆ Students must successfully complete all course requirements as determined by the teacher and the district's grading policy to earn credit.

Accelerated Credits and Enrichment (ACE)

- ◆ A limited selection of classes are available for students to enroll in to advance their middle school options and high school credits.
- ◆ Eighth grade students who will be attending ninth grade in the Fall of the same year may register for the following courses:
 - ◆ Health (HS4910)
 - ◆ Lifetime Fitness (HS4632)
- ◆ To ensure proper credit, counselor or principal approval is required for all Accelerated Credit Courses.
