## IMPORTANT INFORMATION THAT YOU NEED TO KNOW FOR THE 2015 PROGRAM...

**When to Apply?** : Applications will begin being accepted on April 1, 2015

**How to Apply?** : All applicants **MUST** apply online at our website: [www.michigan.gov/mdot-ydmp](http://www.michigan.gov/mdot-ydmp) . We will not accept applications through mail, fax, or that are physically brought in. When you apply, you **MUST** include your **county of residence** in the subject line so that your application is distributed to the correct program coordinator. ( Ex. Oakland , Wayne, Macomb)

**Who Qualifies?** : Student applicants must be currently enrolled in high school, must possess a 2.5 G.P.A., and must be between the ages of 16 to 18 years old. These qualifying students will apply for the **Team Member 1** position. Applicants applying for a leadership positions must be 18+ years old with a valid driver's license. Available positions and pay rates are listed on the YDMP website.

**What do I need to apply?** : High School applicants must submit a copy of their transcripts or most recent grades showing that they have a 2.5 G.P.A, as well as attach a letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or principal. Applicants applying for a leadership positions need to attach a resume' along with their application. (Positions require an interview)

***\*\*Failure to submit proper documents when applying will result in the application being marked as incomplete. Incomplete applications will not be considered for employment.***
